This Month's Speaker - Arthur Pinkers



Photographing Our Orchids

Arthur has been an orchid enthusiast since age 16 (over 40 years) when he acquired a plant of

Slc. Glittering Jewel (Sl. Gratrixiae x Slc. Hermes) and was infected by the orchid bug. His interest in orchids extends over a broad range of types though botanicals are a special draw. Arthur has served most executive positions on the Board of Directors for the Northwest Orchid Society in the mid 1980's and early 1990's and is a Past President. He is the current President of the San Fernando Valley Orchid Society. Arthur is an Accredited Orchid Judge of over 20 years and serves as a one of the center photographers and as Assistant Center Judging Chair for the Pacific South – San Marino Judging center. While in Seattle, he was the center photographer for the Pacific Northwest Judging region.

Arthur moved to Santa Clarita in 2004 with his wife Margie of over 30 years when his work brought him to Southern California. He has two adult children and a granddaughter.

The conditions are extreme for growing orchids and very different from the Pacific Northwest where a greenhouse was a must because of the many cold rainy days. It has been fun learning to grow new general such as Cymbidiums and Zygopetalums than what he grew in the Pacific Northwest along with some favorites in the Cattleya alliance.

He grew up in the Seattle area and attended Western Washington University graduating with a B.S. in Chemistry and Biology. He worked for many years as a chemist and had the fortune of having his dream job as the Lab Director for Beall Orchid Company until shortly before its close in 1990. He then fell back to his second profession in Information technology as a software developer.

Every member is encouraged to bring blooming orchids for judging and to serve as a judge at our meetings. We ask that everyone be aware of the Judging Rules.
Please read up on the current Judging

When bringing your plants for judging, please do your research ahead of time so you know which group your orchid should be placed in.

Although willing to help if time allows, the Judging Chair or any of the judges are not responsible to place your orchid in the correct group. Don't expect these members to know everything – they may award an orchid that is entered in the wrong group, and the error will only be discovered later and then the entry and award is disqualified.

Very important for all entries: Circle the group on the entry form and please print clearly. These forms are collected at the end of the meeting and are the only record of orchids entered for judging. Thank you!
